

#### **Recommendation to Industry**

Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Pandemic Contingency Planning Initial Distribution: March 10, 2020

Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) is a respiratory disease caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus, which was first identified in Wuhan, China on December 8, 2019. The virus has since spread internationally to include confirmed cases in the United States, Canada, and other countries. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) both assess the current risk to the American and Canadian public as "low" as of March 4, 2020, although it is anticipated that the number and geographic dispersion of infected patients will increase in the coming


