

## Panel: Recent EOs and Memos - Energy

#### **Notable actions:**

- National Energy Emergency
- Pause leasing of federal land for wind
- Prioritize Alaskan oil/gas development

## Panel: Recent EOs and Memos - Regulatory

- Unleashing American Energy
  - Orders review of all agency actions that pose "undue burden" to energy development and use
- Regulatory Freeze Pending Review
  - Freeze proposing or issuing new rules until new presidential department/agency head (or their nominee) reviews and approves

- America First Trade Policy
  - Orders broad review of trade policies
  - Outcomes & recommendations due April 1
